Dear Mr. President:

We respectfully request that you promptly consider the August 19, 2019 request from Governor Tony Evers for a major disaster declaration. We endorse the governor's request for a major disaster declaration under the provisions of Section 401 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 5121-5207 (Stafford Act), and implemented by 44CFR § 206.36.

Between July 18 and July 20, a series of severe storms left a wide swath of damage across central and northern Wisconsin. The storms brought gale-force winds, heavy rainfall and subsequent flash flooding, and several tornadoes touched down. The resulting damage included hundreds of toppled utility poles and downed power lines. In addition, two Wisconsinites died while clearing debris.

We believe the damage caused to public infrastructure qualifies this three-day event as a major disaster. Damage and repair costs have been officially estimated at over \$19 million. As noted in the governor's request, the damage inflicted exceeds the response capabilities of the state government and the affected local units of government. It is also our understanding that the state and local governments will assume all applicable non-federal shares of cost, as required by the Stafford Act.

Therefore, in coordination with the damage assessments from FEMA, we support federal assistance via the Public Assistance Program to further recovery efforts in the following 18 counties: Barron, Clark, Forest, La Crosse, Langlade, Marinette, Menominee, Monroe, Oconto, Oneida, Outagamie, Polk, Portage, Rusk, Shawano, Vernon, Waupaca and Wood. In addition, we support the FEMA support being made available to two federally recognized Indian tribes: the Menominee Indian Tribe of Wisconsin, and the St. Croix Chippewa Indians of Wisconsin.
