FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

AUGUST 8, 2013

On August 8, 2013, President Obama issued a major disaster declaration for the State of Wisconsin triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from the Severe Storms, Flooding, and Mudslides that occurred June 20-28, 2013. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-4141-DR

Incident: Severe Storms, Flooding, and Mudslides

Incident Period: June 20-28, 2013

Federal Coordinating Officer: Warren J. Riley
National FCO Program

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Counties: Ashland, Bayfield, Crawford, Grant, Iowa, Richland, St. Croix, and Vernon Counties and the Red Cliff Band of Lake Superior Chippewa in Bayfield County.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long-term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Counties: All counties and Indian Tribes in the State of Wisconsin are eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the state and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
